- 1. Welcome, introductions, attendance and apologies
- 2. Approval of last meetings minutes (18/01/24)
 - a. TR and AR approved
- 3. Matters arising
 - a. FH budget no increase capital spend so no money for community centre.
 Next capital spend will money 25/26. Real times cut of 6%. Scottish government to freeze council cap.
 - ST is money already allocated safe. FH yes money allocated before asbestos was found is still safe. FH says get in writing that it's safe from GlasgowLife and Glasgow Council. (AP JC to email- send individually Martin Booth – financial director; Andrew Olney)
 - ii. ST are we now in recession? FH yes since December.
 - b. Community police update
 - i. Ongoing issues on Shuna Street, maybe in 113. No trouble in 135 since new front door for 5 weeks even though back door still not fixed (MG). LP update from Canal partnership, it is still the plan to get CC (AP JC to get contact for QCHA and MHHA)
 - c. FL
- i. Have contacted GlasgowLife to repair lights on Tamshill. No timeline
- ii. AMcG reported the footpaths having lights out between the streets Brassey and Leighton, Leighton and Brassey. (AP – FL to follow up reports of lighting and map. Also check to see if moss overgrown on footpath).
- iii. JL do anyone check the reports via the app as have reported the street light outings multiple times (4 times since Nov, and in Feb); FL – Yes

- v. VM reported the difficulty with the cycle lane to people and places but no response (**AP FL to follow up**)
- vi. AMcG what's happening with gullys? FL Lots of storms and trees coming down, people have been working elsewhere. FL emailed gully guy, one vehicle had a leak so stopped work. (AP FL to forward report of what has been done so far). Also reminder that we can continue to report flooding on MyGLasgow App
- vii. FL big focus after winter holidays is bins, people from parks etc. Therefore get behind on other jobs.

d. DB - Maryhill Housing

- There is a Glasgow Canal Regeneration Partnership where stated that Glasgow council are looking at feasibility of greening ruchill. First that the Community council has heard about it this initiative and partnership.

- iv. Contractors donated families with 4+ kids cash vouchers for Christmas
- v. Contractor payed for the panto (Cinderella) St Cuthbert school
- vi. Contractors donated toys to nursery (Ruchill) ~£300 of toys
- vii. MHHA focused on energy advice, advocacy, trying to get debts written off (mostly Scottish Gas)
- viii. Tenements sustainability money?
- ix. Mental health of people getting worse due to poor living conditions, gotten so much worse since covid
- x. Scottish welfare fund reduced, so MHHA having to plug more gaps in support for tenants (eg second hand furniture)
- xi. Is there still plans for building on Golf course? DB don't know. There is going to be a Glasgow council paid survey of site
- xii. VM No investment in tenements in Bisland drive, water streaming down walls outside (near Mayfield shop). DB investment team looks at different repairs on a cycle. Priorities have been internal water leaks?.(AP DB to look at where guttering is in investment cycle and to flag gutters and water damage).
- xiii. BL How do families request repairs to kitchens.? DB Not sure (AP DB to find out, there is a customer service contact). BL some don't know who their housing officer is.

4. Officer update/reports

a. Secretary

i. Reminder to please send apologies and items for the agenda in advance.

b. Planning and licensing

- i. Community councils from other areas have resources that could share for gala day. Milton have a new bouncy castle. BL – may be easier to get an area partnership grant and have insurance rather than trying to manage activities ourselves
- ii. AP FL will send JC/AMcGa community permission to use form (needs to be submitted to Glasgow Council at least 6 weeks before event)
- iii. Risk assessment needs to be done for all organisations at event and submitted to GC
- iv. But organisation involved need own public liability insurance (needs to be checked by Ruchill CC as part of risk assessment)
- v. DB west fest, over month of events 1-30th June. Maybe avoid these dates
- vi. Choose date to miss other events, AP LP to check dates from last year to find what would make sense this year
- vii. If need money from area partnership for event need to be costed and apply by12th March
- viii. Communities events Scotland plan and organise events, take some stress out of planning. But will still need volunteers
- ix. Canal Area Partnership meeting update Police had applied for money ~£5000, then given extra £3000 for safety of victims

c. Treasurer

- i. Bank should be up and running in the next few days, been trying for weeks but bank lost some documents
- ii. AMcG and MJ are the signatories
- iii. £4234.79 currently in the account. Usually automatically put in account £700 every year around October/November. AP AMcG to check with Lawrence if this will be done late for Ruchill CC.
